The proposed amendments are either administrative in nature or intended to implement existing state law and/or federal requirements for which the time for substantive public involvement already occurred prior to enactment. However, with respect to the adoption of the federal requirements for permitting of greenhouse gases, the Agency intends to notify the existing facilities that will most likely be subject to these federal requirements and solicit their comments. In addition, the proposed rule and the rule adoption schedule will be posted on the Air Pollution Control Division's website. The Agency also intends to hold a public hearing on the proposed rule amendments.
