

# Fifteenth Annual Report on the Status of the Petroleum Cleanup Fund

**10 VSA § 1941**

**This report includes a review of Petroleum Cleanup Fund receipts and disbursements for the calendar and fiscal year 2002. An evaluation of the effectiveness of the Fund in meeting its legislative intent, and a review of the reasonableness of remediation costs is also included. **Executive Summary**

This is the fifteenth annual Petroleum Cleanup Fund (PCF) report submitted in accordance with 10 V.S.A. § 1941; it includes a review of receipts and disbursements for 2002. The report also evaluates the effectiveness of the PCF in meeting its legislative intent, reviews the reasonableness of remediation costs, and recommends statutory amendments. This report also provides recommendations to address a growing problem of heating oil releases from both aboveground and underground heating oil storage tanks.

The Advisory Committee has identified three priority items that will need to be addressed if the PCF is to continue to meet its legislative intent.

- The PCF sunset dates should be extended for an additional 5 years;
- A fee on heating oil and kerosene should be authorized to account for the heating oil and kerosene cleanups that utilize the PCF;
- Monies transferred from the PCF by the 2002 legislature should be repaid in order to maintain fund solvency.

One of the primary purposes of the PCF has been to provide a means for underground storage tank owners to meet state and federal requirements for financial responsibility (FR) to address contamination from leaking underground storage tanks. As presently written, the Fund will sunset on July 1, 2004 and at that point tank owners will need to secure another FR mechanism. Private insurance remains either unaffordable or difficult to procure for many tank owners. The Committee, after seeking input from the tank owners, recommends a 5 year extension to the PCF. This action should be a high priority in the 2003 legislative session.

The current financial condition of the PCF cannot support the continued reimbursement of cleanup costs from heating oil releases from both aboveground and underground heating oil storage tanks without additional revenue. The Committee recommends that a separate fund be created to address these risks, financed by a fee on heating oil and kerosene. If no additional revenue is identified then heating oil and kerosene related activities should be removed from PCF eligibility.

During the 2002 legislative session, \$1,776,000 was transferred from the PCF into the state's general fund making the total general fund transfers since the fund began to \$5,501,000. The transfer of these monies has reduced the fund's balance to a point where future payments may be in jeopardy. The fund is required by EPA to maintain a \$1 million reserve. Future projections indicate that demands on the PCF will exceed future revenue, reducing the balance to below the \$1 million mandated reserve. At that point the PCF will not be considered a viable FR mechanism, and tank owners will be found to be in violation of state and federal law. To prevent this from occurring, monies transferred in 2002 should be returned to the PCF immediately, and other past transfers should be repaid over time.

## **Description and Purpose**

This is the fifteenth annual report on the status of the PCF. This report will look at the effectiveness of the fund in meeting its intended purpose, will review the status of cleanups from motor fuel and heating oil releases from both aboveground and underground heating oil storage tanks, will review the results of the farm and residential UST removal grant program and will provide future PCF projections and recommendations for changes to the PCF.

In 1985, the General Assembly enacted Vermont's first law to regulate the construction, maintenance and operation of underground steel tanks used for the storage of petroleum products. Act 66 of the 1985 session established standards for new construction, and set a deadline of June 30, 1998, later amended to December 22, 1998, for the removal or replacement of unprotected USTs.

In 1988 the Legislature created the PCF, and appointed this advisory committee to oversee the financing, effectiveness and conduct of the program and the fund which supports it. The primary purpose of the PCF is to protect public health and the environment by paying for cleanup and restoration of contaminated soil and groundwater caused by releases from underground petroleum storage tanks, and to compensate third parties for property damage and bodily injury. Many changes have been made since 1988, including the inclusion of pollution coverage for aboveground storage tanks (ASTs) and a farm and residential UST removal grant program. The Fund also provides loans to small marketers and small towns for tank replacement.

The PCF provides financial assurance to UST owners, who are required by state and federal law to provide coverage for up to \$1 million for cleanup and \$1 million for third party liability. Since such insurance coverage remains unavailable, or at least unaffordable for most owners, the PCF enables tank owners to meet this requirement. By law, the U.S. EPA must approve the operation and viability of a state fund before it may serve as a financial responsibility mechanism for UST owners. EPA accepted Vermont's fund as a financial assurance mechanism in 1990, with the requirement that a minimum balance of \$1 million be maintained. This requirement is noted in the committee's financial attachments.

Revenue comes from an annual assessment fee of up to \$200 per tank on most underground tanks, and a "distributor licensing fee" of one cent per gallon of motor fuel sold in the state. Additional revenue comes from the repayment of loans, recovery of some costs from responsible parties, and interest accruing upon any cash balance in the fund.

Expenditures include the cost of cleanup, third party payments, loans to businesses and municipalities, grants to homeowners to assist in the removal of heating oil USTs and modest administrative expenses. Each uninsured cleanup undertaken in the state becomes eligible for fund assistance after the party responsible for the tank meets a certain "deductible," a co-insurance payment based on the circumstances of ownership. For commercial entities, the deductible is set at \$10,000 per occurrence. For homeowners, a deductible of \$250 must be met. Owners of commercial heating oil ASTs meet a \$1000 deductible.

In 1998, the previous deadline for filing claims against the PCF was extended to July 1, 2004, and the "sunset" date for collection of the distributor licensing fee was extended to April 1, 2006.

## Risks to Fund Solvency

The greatest potential risks to the solvency of the PCF include potential large scale cleanups at contaminated properties, unforeseen third party claims and past and future legislatively authorized transfers of the PCF balance to the state's General Fund.

**The current PCF balance of \$1,560,355 and projections for revenue and expenses is inadequate to address future needs and threatens current obligations.** The large number of contaminated properties that are eligible for reimbursement under the Fund will continue to require significant PCF monies. Ninety-eight new sites were discovered in 2002 adding to the total of over 2,400 sites discovered statewide since 1988. This large number of contaminated properties will result in an increase in the disbursements from the PCF as investigations and cleanups continue. There are also 20 different sites where extensive remediation is necessary, and the DEC has committed to over \$3 million for these cleanups under the pay-for-performance program.

Providing reimbursements for releases at heating oil and kerosene sites remains a risk to the PCF (Attachment 4). **The current financial condition of the PCF can not support these cleanups without additional revenue.** This problem is compounded by an inadequate fund balance. In 2002, the total heating oil related reimbursements included \$80,622 for UST releases, \$216,616 for AST releases and \$120,211 for the UST residential heating oil removal grant program, for a total of \$417,449. Since 1994 (the date UST heating oil tanks were added to the PCF), over \$4 million, or approximately 7% of all disbursements, have been made for heating oil related activities. This added risk to the PCF can not be sustained unless there is appropriate funding to support these activities.

There also remains the threat of a large petroleum release in a critical area. Over the history of the program, the sites that have affected public water supplies or sensitive environmental areas have required extensive remediation at a high cost to the PCF. In 2002, a site was discovered in Hartland where over 30 public and private wells have been contaminated with a gasoline additive, MTBE. This site will require a large disbursement of PCF monies to address this problem. In addition, there are 2 sites that have received reimbursements totaling more than \$1,000,000 each for remediation costs, and 130 sites that have required cleanup costs of more than \$100,000 each. When sites like these are discovered, cleanup work can continue, at a large fund expense, for as long as 5-10 years.

Third party claims constitute an uncertain risk. Cumulative third party claims of \$2.5 million to date represent only 4% of the total disbursements from the Fund. However, a major release in a critical area, such as a public water supply or high density residential area, could result in a costly third party claim. Contaminated water supplies represent the majority of all third party claims. Future discovery of contaminated public water supplies is anticipated, since there are 38 leaking underground storage tank sites located in close proximity to public water supplies. There are an approximate 370 private wells at 123 sites serving an estimated population of over 1,000 people that have been contaminated by petroleum from leaking USTs. Attachment 5 shows the distribution of sites with a direct and immediate effect on public health and the environment over the past sixteen years. The Fund continued to provide reimbursements to municipalities where petroleum contaminated soils were encountered during public water or sewer lines projects. The added cost of properly handling the contaminated material as well as having proper personal protection for the on site workers is a third party cost eligible for reimbursement from the Fund. Each year this is an uncertain risk to the Fund.

In the 2002 legislative session, \$1,776,000 was transferred from the PCF into the state's general fund making the total general fund transfers since the fund began to \$5,501,000. The transfer of these monies have reduced the fund's balance to a point where future payments may be in jeopardy. The fund is required by EPA to maintain a \$1 million reserve. Future projections indicate that demands on the PCF will exceed future revenue, reducing the balance to below the \$1 million mandated reserve. At that point the PCF will not be considered a viable FR mechanism and tank owners will be found to be in violation of state and federal law. To prevent this from occurring, monies transferred in 2002 and in the past, should be returned to the PCF, which will provide the resources necessary to mitigate the serious effects of petroleum tank releases.

## **Review of Receipts to the Fund**

A review of fund receipts for calendar year 2002 is summarized in Attachments 1 and 6. In 2002, total fund receipts were \$6,466,076 which was a 33% increase as compared to 2001 income. This increase was primarily attributed to a significant cost recovery settlement. Owners of "Category One" storage tanks paid \$366,134 in tank assessment fees. The distributor licensing fee, a one cent assessment per gallon of motor fuel sold in the state, contributed \$4,351,114, a 10% increase compared to 2001. Other income includes the repayment of loans, \$464,577, and interest income of \$62,460. No interest income was posted to the PCF the last six months of the year. This will occur in 2003, which will increase the annual interest income in that year. Lastly, a cost recovery case was settled in February 2002, which resulted in the repayment of \$1,050,000 of PCF funds. The case involved a tank owner that had private insurance which included third party coverage. The PCF provided funds for the restoration of the bedrock drinking water aquifer serving numerous third party drinking water wells. A court decision that these costs should have been insured lead to the repayment of these funds.

## **Review of Disbursements from the Fund**

A review of fund disbursements for calendar year 2002 is summarized in Attachments 1,2 and 6. A review of fund disbursements over the history of the PCF is summarized in Attachments 8. In 2002, disbursements totaling \$6,072,113 included \$322,418 for the UST replacement loan program, \$120,211 for the residential UST removal grant program, \$3,404,015 for remedial action, \$79,999 that is encumbered for 20 pay-for-performance cleanup sites, \$232,500 for administrative costs, and \$216,969 for third party claims. In addition, \$1,776,000 was transferred from the PCF into the state's general fund. Attachments 1 and 6 presents a tabular summary of this information.

Disbursements for remediation in 2002 represented a total of 933 different sites (Attachment 2), which includes sites which began remediation in prior years. One hundred thirty of these sites required cleanup costing more than \$100,000, with 14 of these sites costing more than \$500,000. Two sites have cost more than \$1 million. One of these cost over \$1.2 million; however, this site involves two separate properties where releases occurred, but the contamination is being managed as one site due to their close proximity and their effect on a public water supply. The other site also involves significant contamination to a bedrock aquifer, and was the subject of the 2002 cost recovery case. There are 20 different sites where extensive remediation is necessary, and the DEC has established agreements to reimburse over \$3 million for these cleanups. The cleanups for these sites are under the pay-for-performance (PFP) cleanup program. Under PFP cleanup, contractors are paid based on the effectiveness of the cleanup and not on a traditional time and materials basis. In 2002, remediation costs also included the reimbursement of

\$80,622 at heating oil UST sites and \$216,616 at above ground storage tank sites. Lastly, 121 incentive grants were issued in 2002 for the closure of residential heating oil tanks totaling \$120,211. This brings the total grants awarded since 1998 to 319.

In all, sites in 191 different towns have had investigations or cleanups that have benefitted from the use of the Fund. Attachment 7 shows the distribution of these sites throughout the state.

In 2002 the owners of 9 facilities qualified for UST loans totaling \$345,000. One owner qualified for a tank replacement loan of \$40,000, and the remaining 8 were for upgrade of existing equipment. All of the loans have been approved. This brings the total number of facilities that have taken advantage of UST replacements loans to 160 and 18 additional facilities obtaining loans to upgrade existing equipment. As of December 31, 2002, 8 were closed with \$322,418 disbursed, which includes the administrative cost to secure the loans. The remaining upgrade loan totaling \$25,000 will likely close with the funds disbursed in the second quarter of 2003.

Third party claims continue to represent a small portion of overall disbursements (4%). To date the PCF has paid \$2,578,829 for all third party claims, with \$216,969 in 2002 (Attachment 2).

### **Effectiveness of the Fund in Meeting Its Purpose**

The Petroleum Cleanup Fund was able to meet its obligations throughout 2002 but with financial difficulties. The \$1.7 M transfer of PCF funds to the general fund made it necessary for the Agency of Natural Resources to notify tank owners and consultants that there could be delays in payments due to insufficient funds. This notification causes delays in many of the site cleanups as consultants felt the need to develop new contracts which ensured their payment for services. The successful cost recovery of \$1,050,000 of past cleanup costs helped to provide additional funds which made it possible to complete the necessary investigations and cleanups at identified tank sites, and to respond to petroleum impacts to third parties. **However, future projections show that, without the additional revenue provided by a fee on heating oil and kerosene, there will be inadequate funds to address future needs.**

### **Reasonableness of the Cost of Cleanup**

The committee has reviewed the written policies and procedures of the DEC related to UST replacement, eligible costs and reimbursement procedures. In assessing the reasonableness of the cost of cleanup, the committee has reviewed national averages and comparative data from other states. The PCF Advisory Committee has concluded that agency staff responsible for this program have exercised commendable and prudent cost containment measures. A review of an annual survey conducted by the Association of State Underground Storage Tank Cleanup Funds shows that Vermont's cost of cleaning up contaminated sites is below those of other states. The continued efforts of agency staff have helped to maintain reasonable cleanup costs in Vermont. The implementation of Vermont's pay-for-performance cleanup agreements has also helped to control costs.

### **Review of Cleanups from Heating Oil Releases from ASTs and USTs**

PCF coverage was made available for uninsured costs from heating oil releases from both ASTs (1998) and USTs (1994). As of the end of 2002, the PCF has provided over \$4,019,987 for these

cleanups (Attachment 4). With claims on the rise for heating oil related cleanups, the 2000 legislature requested that the PCF Advisory Committee make recommendations for future PCF coverage. Due to an increase in the number of sites where the cleanups were not covered by private insurance, and with contamination affecting public health and the environment, the Committee recommended that PCF coverage continue for these releases only if there is the establishment of a ½ cent fee on heating oil and kerosene. If no additional revenue is provided to support these activities, then the Committee recommends that heating oil related activities be removed from the PCF.

## **Recommended Statutory Changes to Chapter 59**

### **1. Reauthorize PCF for an additional 5 years**

#### **A. Amend §§ 1941. Petroleum cleanup fund**

(a) A fund to be known as the petroleum cleanup fund is created in the state treasury, to be expended by the secretary of the agency of natural resources. The fund shall consist of licensing fees and petroleum tank fees assessed under the provisions of this chapter, loan repayments, and disbursements that have been recovered, except for underground storage tank permit fees and licensing fees for tank inspectors. All balances in the fund at the end of any fiscal year shall be carried forward and remain a part of the fund. Interest earned by the fund shall be deposited into the fund. Disbursements from the fund shall be made by the state treasurer on warrants drawn by the commissioner of finance and management. The secretary shall seek to recover from responsible parties costs incurred under subdivision (b)(8) of this section.

(b) The secretary may authorize disbursements from the fund for the purpose of the cleanup and restoration of contaminated soil and groundwater caused by releases of petroleum from underground storage tanks and aboveground storage tanks, including air emissions for remedial actions, and for compensation of third parties for injury and damage caused by a release. This fund shall be used for no other governmental purposes, nor shall any portion hereof ever be available to borrow from by any branch of government; it being the intent of the Legislature that this fund and its increments shall remain intact and inviolate for the purposes set out in this chapter. Disbursements under this section may be made only for uninsured costs incurred after January 1, 1987 and for which a claim is made prior to July 1, ~~2004~~ 2009 and judged to be in conformance with prevailing industry rates. This includes:

#### **B. Amend §§ 1942. Petroleum distributor licensing fee**

There is hereby established a licensing fee of one cent per gallon of motor fuel sold by a distributor or dealer or used by a user in this state, which will be assessed against every distributor, dealer or user as defined in 23 V.S.A. chapters 27 and 28, and which will be deposited into the petroleum cleanup fund. This fee will be paid in the same manner, at the same time, and subject to the same restrictions or limitations as the tax on motor fuels. The fee will be collected by the commissioner of motor vehicles and deposited into the petroleum cleanup fund. This fee requirement shall terminate on April 1, ~~2006~~ 2011. (Added 1987, No. 282 (Adj. Sess.), §§ 2, eff. April 1, 1989; amended 1989, No. 110, §§ 9, eff. June 20, 1989; 1993, No. 188 (Adj. Sess.), §§ 2; 1997, No. 132 (Adj. Sess.), §§ 9, eff. ### C. Amend §§ 1943. Petroleum tank assessment

(a) Each owner of a category one tank used for storage of petroleum products shall remit to the secretary on October 1 of each year beginning October 1, 1988, \$200.00 per tank, which shall be deposited to the petroleum cleanup fund established by section 1941 of this title except that:

(1) The fee shall be \$100.00 per tank for retail gasoline outlets that sell less than 40,000 gallons of motor fuel per month; or

(2) The fee shall be reduced by 50 percent if the owner or permittee provides to the satisfaction of the secretary evidence of financial responsibility to allow the taking of corrective action in the amount of \$100,000.00 per occurrence and the compensation of third parties for bodily injury and property damage in the amount of \$300,000.00 per occurrence; or

(3) The fee shall be relieved if the owner provides to the satisfaction of the secretary, evidence of financial responsibility to allow the taking of corrective action and the compensation of third parties for bodily injury and property damage each in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence.

(4) The fee for retail motor fuel outlets selling 20,000 gallons or less per month shall not exceed \$200.00 per year for all tanks at a single location.

(5) The fee shall be \$100.00 per tank for any municipality that uses less than an annual average of 40,000 gallons of motor fuel per month, provided that all of the tanks of that municipality meet the requirements of this chapter.

(b) For purposes of this section, an occurrence is an accident, including continuous or repeated exposure to conditions, which results in the release of petroleum from one or more underground storage tanks at the same site.

(c) This tank assessment shall terminate on July 1, ~~2004~~ 2009.

(d) The secretary shall establish forms and procedures for the payment of the petroleum tank assessment, including a notice of the obligation 30 days prior to being due. Failure to receive notice shall not waive the payment obligation. (Added 1987, No. 282 (Adj. Sess.), §§ 3; amended 1989, No. 110, §§§§ 9a, 10; 1993, No. 188 (Adj. Sess.), §§ 3; 1997, No. 132 (Adj. Sess.), §§ 10, eff. April 23, 1998.)

## 2. Establish a fee on heating oil and kerosene

### A. § 1942. Petroleum Distributor Licensing Fee

There is hereby established a licensing fee of one cent per gallon of motor fuel sold by a distributor or dealer or used by a user in this state and a licensing fee of one-half cent per gallon of heating oil and kerosene, which will be assessed against every distributor, dealer or user as defined in 23 V.S.A. chapters 27 and 28, and which will be deposited into the petroleum cleanup fund. ~~This fee~~ These fees will be paid in the same manner, at the same time, and subject to the same restrictions or limitations as the tax on motor fuels. ~~The fee~~ These fees will be collected by the commissioner of motor vehicles and deposited into the petroleum cleanup fund. ~~This~~ Prior to January 1 and June 30

each year, the balance in the petroleum cleanup fund will be evaluated. If the fund balance exceeds \$4.5 million, then the fees will not be collected until such time as the balance falls below \$2.5 million. These fee requirement requirements shall terminate on April 1, 2006.

B. § 1941. Petroleum Cleanup Fund

(a) A fund to be known as the petroleum cleanup fund is created in the state treasury, to be expended by the secretary of the agency of natural resources. The fund shall consist of licensing fees and petroleum tank fees assessed under the provisions of this chapter, loan repayments, and disbursements that have been recovered, except for underground storage tank permit fees and licensing fees for tank inspectors. The fund shall have two accounts: the motor fuel account and the heating oil and kerosene fuel account. The motor fuel account shall consist of all moneys deposited into the fund, with the exception of the licensing fees for heating oil and kerosene described in section 1942 of this title. The heating oil and kerosene fuel account shall consist of all the moneys deposited into the fund from the licensing fees for heating oil and kerosene sold or used in the state. All balances in the fund at the end of any fiscal year shall be carried forward and remain a part of the fund. Interest earned by the fund shall be deposited into the fund. Disbursements from the fund shall be made by the state treasurer on warrants drawn by the commissioner of finance and management. The secretary shall seek to recover from responsible parties costs incurred under subdivision (b)(8) of this section.

(b) The secretary may authorize disbursements from the fund for the purpose of the cleanup and restoration of contaminated soil and groundwater caused by releases of petroleum from underground storage tanks and aboveground storage tanks, including air emissions for remedial actions, and for compensation of third parties for injury and damage caused by a release. Disbursements under this section may be made only for uninsured costs incurred after January 1, 1987 and for which a claim is made prior to July 1, 2004 and judged to be in conformance with prevailing industry rates. This includes:

(1) costs incurred by taking corrective action as directed by the secretary for any release of petroleum into the environment from:

(A) an underground motor fuel storage tank site after the first \$10,000.00 of costs have been borne by the owners or permittee. Disbursements on any site shall not exceed \$990,000.00. These disbursements shall be made from the motor fuel account;

(B) an underground heating fuel tank used for on-premise heating after the first \$10,000 of the cleanup costs have been borne by the owners or operators of tanks with capacities over 1,100 gallons used for commercial purposes, or after the first \$250 of the cleanup costs have been borne by the owners or operators of tanks with capacities equal to or less than 1,100 gallons used for commercial purposes, or after the first \$250 of the cleanup costs have been borne by the owners or operators of residential and farm tanks. These disbursements shall be made from the heating fuel account.

(C) an aboveground heating fuel storage tank site after the first \$1,000.00 of the cleanup costs have been borne by the owners or operators of tanks used for commercial purposes, or after the first \$250.00 of the cleanup costs have been borne by the owners or operators of

residential and farm tanks. Disbursements under this subdivision (b)(1)(B) on any individual site shall not exceed \$25,000.00. These disbursements shall be made from the heating fuel account;

(D) a bulk storage aboveground motor fuel or heating fuel storage tank site after the first \$25,000.00 of the cleanup costs have been borne by the owners or operators of tanks used for commercial purposes. Disbursements under this subdivision (b)(1)(C) on any individual site shall not exceed \$975,000.00. These disbursements shall be made from the motor fuel account;

(2) costs incurred in compensating third parties for bodily injury and property damage, as approved by the secretary in consultation with the commissioner of banking, insurance, securities, and health care administration caused by release of petroleum from an underground motor fuel storage tank into the environment from a site, up to one million dollars, but shall not include payment of any punitive damages;

\* \* \*

(5) notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision (b)(1) of this section, costs incurred by taking corrective action as directed by the secretary for any release of petroleum into the environment after the first \$250.00 of costs have been borne by the owners or permittee for the following underground storage tanks:

(A) any size farm or residential heating fuel oil storage tank used for on-premises heating;

(B) all farm or residential motor fuel tanks with capacities of equal to or less than 1,100 gallons;

(C) all nonfarm and nonresidential heating fuel oil storage tanks used for on-premises heating with capacities of equal to or less than 1,100 gallons;

\* \* \*

(c) The secretary may use up to one-half the amount deposited to the motor fuel account of the fund from the licensing fees assessed under section 1942 of this title to capitalize the underground motor fuel storage tank loan assistance program established by section 1944 of this title and the cost of administering the program. If the secretary determines that a balance will remain after all qualifying loan applications have been satisfied, the unneeded balance may be used for cleanup. The secretary may use ~~up to \$250,000 per year~~ the amount in the heating fuel account of the fund for purposes of funding measures related to ~~aboveground tanks~~ heating oil and kerosene.

(e) The secretary shall establish a petroleum cleanup fund advisory committee which shall meet not less than annually to review receipts and disbursements from the fund, to evaluate the effectiveness of the fund in meeting its purposes, the reasonableness of the cost of cleanup and to recommend alterations and statutory amendments deemed appropriate. The advisory committee shall submit an annual report of its findings to the general assembly on January 15 of each year. In its annual report ~~for 2000~~, the advisory committee shall review the financial stability of the fund, evaluate the implementation of assistance related to underground farm or residential heating fuel oil storage tanks and aboveground storage tanks, and the need for continuing assistance, and shall include recommendations for sustainable funding sources to finance the provision of that assistance. The membership of the committee shall include the following or their designated representative:

(1) the secretary of the agency of natural resources who shall be chairperson;

- (2) the commissioner of the department of environmental conservation;
- (3) the commissioner of banking, insurance, securities, and health care administration;
- (4) a licensed gasoline distributor;
- (5) a retail gasoline dealer;
- (6) a representative of a statewide refining-marketing petroleum association;
- (7) one member of the house to be appointed by the speaker of the house;
- (8) one member of the senate to be appointed by the committee on committees.
- (9) a licensed heating fuel dealer;
- (10) a representative of a statewide heating fuel dealers' association;
- (11) a licensed real estate broker;

\* \* \*

(g) The owner of a farm or residential underground heating fuel oil storage tank used for on-premises heating that desires assistance to close, replace, or upgrade the tank may apply to the secretary for such assistance. The financial assistance may be in the form of grants or loans of up to \$1,000.00 or the costs of closure, replacement, or upgrade, whichever is less. Grants or loans shall be made only to the current property owners. To be eligible to receive the grant or loan, an environmental site assessment must be conducted by a qualified consultant during the underground heating fuel storage tank closure, replacement, or upgrade. In addition, if the closed tank is to be replaced with another underground heating fuel storage tank, the replacement tank and piping shall provide a level of environmental protection at least equivalent to that provided by a double wall tank and secondarily contained piping. Grants or loans shall be awarded on a priority basis to projects that will avoid the greatest environmental or health risks. The secretary shall also give priority to applicants who are replacing their underground heating fuel tanks with above ground heating fuel storage tanks, that will be installed in accordance with the secretary's recommended standards. The secretary shall also give priority to lower income applicants. ~~The secretary shall only authorize up to \$100,000.00 in assistance grants or loans in any one fiscal year.~~ The owner of a farm or residential aboveground heating fuel storage tank used for on-premises heating that desires assistance to close, replace, or upgrade the tank may apply to the secretary for such assistance. The financial assistance may be in the form of grants or loans of up to \$1,000.00 or the costs of closure, replacement, or upgrade, whichever is less. Grants or loans shall be made only to the current property owners. To be eligible to receive the grant or loan, the owner must provide the previous year's financial information. Any work to replace or upgrade a tank must be done in accordance with industry standards (National Fire Protection Association, or NFPA, Code 31). The secretary shall provide these loans or grants to low income applicants based on eligibility criteria that are consistent with the economic assistance authorized under the home heating fuel assistance program. The secretary shall only authorize up to \$150,000.00 in assistance for underground and aboveground heating fuel tanks in any one fiscal year from the heating fuel account for this purpose. The application must be accompanied by the following information:

- (1) proof of ownership, including information disclosing all owners of record of the property;
- (2) for farm or residential aboveground heating fuel storage tank owners, a copy of the federal income tax return for the previous year;

(3) identification of the contractor performing any aboveground heating fuel storage tank closure, replacement, or upgrade;

~~(3)~~(4) an estimated cost of tank closure, replacement or upgrade;

~~(4)~~(5) the amount and type of assistance requested;

~~(5)~~(6) a schedule for the work;

~~(6)~~(7) description of surrounding area, including location of water supply wells, surface waters and other sensitive receptors; and

~~(7)~~(8) such other information and assurances as the secretary may require.

(i) Any aboveground heating fuel storage tank installed or replaced after July 1, 2003 shall be installed in compliance with National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) Code 31.

For each site with an affected receptor the number of actual Vermonters exposed to contamination can vary. The actual users for public water supplies can be as low as 25 people per system to as high as many thousands of users. The 38 affected public water supplies in this table represent both small and large systems. For sites with affected private water supplies, the average number of contaminated wells is three per site, with an average of 3 users per household. However, one of the 123 sites listed above involved contamination to over 80 wells affecting approximately 240 users, and a recent site discovered in 2002 involves contamination to over 30 wells, including a public water supply, affecting 100s of users. Sites with surface water impacts can affect both public health and the environment. High concentrations of petroleum in a stream can cause detrimental affects to biota, and lead to an increased exposure to stream users. Lastly, sites with indoor air impacts can lead to the greatest risk to public health. Petroleum vapors entering a home can be at levels that are explosive. More often petroleum vapors reach levels that pose a serious health risk. Of the 87 sites with indoor air impacts, the number of exposed individuals varied from site to site. An average site involves three homes affected with approximately three persons per home.




