UNDERGROUND INJECTION CONTROL PERMIT APPLICATION PUBLIC NOTICE

April 21, 2016

On March 21, 2016, Imerys Talc Vermont, Inc., filed (#2DX-4YYY-CR57), supplemental renewal application materials for an underground injection control (UIC) permit, for the continued operation of a stormwater drainage discharge system in accordance with UIC Program requirements. The application was resubmitted on April 20, 2016 with minor revisions (version 2).

The Imerys Talc Vermont, Inc. Argonaut, Blackbear and Rainbow Mine Sites are located adjacent to, and east of East Hill Road primarily in the Town of Ludlow, with eastern portions of the property located in the Town of Cavendish and southern portions in the Town of Chester. Drainage from the mine sites is collected, treated and currently permitted to discharge to two infiltration basins on the property in accordance with conditions outlined in UIC Permit #6-0019. No increase in discharge to the UIC basins is proposed.

Original renewal application materials were received on April 7, 2008. The UIC Rules were amended and became effective on October 29, 2014. Supplemental application materials were requested in accordance with the amended Rule. Imerys Talc Vermont, Inc. maintains its' permit status in accordance with Title 3 Section 814, until a determination is made on the pending application.
