We received your letter dated September 8, 2014 with attachments requesting approval of effluent filter model ML2-416 manufactured by Bear Onsite, LLC in accordance with Section 1-904(e) of the Wastewater System and Potable Water Supply Rules (Rules), effective dated September 29, 2007.

The Rules require that the “effluent filter be tested and shown to prevent the passage of solids larger in size than 1/8th inch.” You included information on the NSF/ANSI Standard 46 testing on Model ML2-416 indicating it conforms to the requirements of NSF/ANSI Standard 46-2010.

Based on the information you submitted, the model referenced in this letter meets the requirements of the Rules and can be used in septic tank installations in Vermont.
