LICENSED DESIGNER CONTINUING EDUCATION

An affidavit must be submitted to the <u>Office of Professional Regulation</u> every two years confirming completion of 12 Continuing Education credit hours, including at least 4 credit hours of practical soil training. The credit hours for each course or conference must be endorsed by the Drinking Water and Groundwater Protection Division of the DEC.
