- § 1-301 Permit Required § 1-301(a) Has 13 triggers
 - The conversion of an existing public water system to a potable water supply
 - The conversion of an indirect discharge system to a wastewater system
- § 1-301(b) Allows use of portions of existing wastewater systems and potable water supplies
- § 1-301(e) Prohibitions to a wastewater system
 - UIC Class I, II, III and most of IV wells
 - UIC Class V wells
 - Wastes requiring UIC permit
 - Wastes adversely affecting biological action

- § 1-301(g) Actions not considered a flow increase
 - A home occupation
 - Addition of plumbing to a single-family residence
 - Addition of a water storage tank for a single-family residence
 - Addition of bedrooms to a 3 bedroom single-family residence when
 - Served by public water
 - Served by a municipal wastewater treatment facility

 - § 1-305(d) Flagging to remain until permit or denial issued, or application withdrawn
 - § 1-305(i) Certification for use of surface water
 - § 1-305(l) Design deference list
