**APPROVAL OF REDEMPTION CENTERS &
 BEVERAGE CONTAINERS; DEPOSIT-REDEMPTION SYSTEM**

SUMMARY DESCRIPTION OF PERMIT	Allows for the certification of redemption centers and approves all beverage container labels that are required to carry the "VT 5¢" message.
EXAMPLES OF REGULATED ACTIVITY	Certifies redemption centers. Registers beverage manufacturers prior to the sale of malt beverages, mineral waters, mixed wine drinks, soda water, carbonated soft drinks, liquor and spirits in Vermont.
INFORMATION REQUIRED	Submittal of redemption center certification applications indicating the location of the redemption center and the estimated number of containers handled per year. Submittal of beverage manufacturer registrations prior to product being sold or distributed in Vermont.

APPLICATION TIME FRAME	30 days upon submittal of all required information.

AUTHORITY	10 V.S.A. Chapter 53
APPLICABLE RULES	Environmental Protection Regulations, Chapter 10, Deposit for Beverage Containers
APPEAL PROCESS	Any person aggrieved by an act or decision of the Secretary, or any party by right, may appeal to the Environmental Court within 30 days of the date of the act or decision in accordance with the provisions of 10 V.S.A. Chapter 220 and the Vermont Rules of Environmental Court Proceedings.
