**OPERATING CERTIFICATE - BOILER AND PRESSURE VESSEL**

**SUMMARY DESCRIPTION OF PERMIT**

A boiler or pressure vessel for a public building is required to be inspected prior to being placed in service, and is then required to be inspected on a periodic basis to insure that the unit meets the requirements for installation and maintenance.

**INFORMATION REQUIRED**

Owner/operators of boilers and pressure vessels must have initial operating inspections and periodic inspections conducted by boiler inspectors approved by the Division of Fire Safety. Operating certificate and inspection information is reported to the Division.
