**PERMIT AND LICENSE INFORMATION**

**OFF-AIRPORT AERIAL PERMITS**

<b>SUMMARY DESCRIPTION OF PERMIT</b>	Aerial spraying, parachute exhibitions and air shows require Agency approval. AOT Approval indicates compliance with all statutory requirements and minimum safety standards.
<b>EXAMPLE OF REGULATED ACTIVITY</b>	Airplane or helicopter agricultural application, exhibition parachute jumps for compensation and organized air shows including aerobatic maneuvers and parachute jumps.
<b>CRITERIA FOR JURISDICTION</b>	Aerial spraying permit requires a certificate from VT Department of Agriculture. Parachute exhibition permit requires written municipal approval, and notification to FAA. Air show permit requires a Certificate of Waiver from FAA
<b>INFORMATION REQUIRED</b>	For aerial spraying, completed application form noting areas to be sprayed and list of approved chemicals. For Parachute permits completed application form including correspondence from the appropriate town Recreation and Parks director or equivalent indicating municipal approval. For an air show, completed application form, diagram of proposed aerobatic performance area, completed copy of FAA Form 7711-2 as filed with the FAA and must possess and have available for inspection the Certificate of Waiver from FAA.

<b>APPLICATION TIME FRAME</b>	One month.
