**SUMMARY
DESCRIPTION
OF PERMIT**

Permit required for any application of a pesticide via fixed wing aircraft or helicopter.

Spraying apple orchards.

Information on materials proposed for use, labels, rates and sites of use.

**APPLICATION
TIME FRAME**

Annual permits required for spraying agricultural commodities. For other applications, a permit is required for each contract to apply pesticides. Permits good for only one spray season. Application approval process takes approximately 1 week.

Vermont Regulations for the Control of Pesticides; Section IV, 5.

**APPEAL
PROCESS**

Permit conditions may be appealed to the Commissioner within 15 days of receipt of notice of the decision.

**OTHER PERMITS
AND APPROVALS**

Applicants must meet FAA and Vermont AOT requirements to operate aircraft.
