SUMMARY **DESCRIPTION OF PERMIT** 

Permit required for any application of a pesticide via fixed wing aircraft or

helicopter.

Spraying apple orchards.

Information on materials proposed for use, labels, rates and sites of use.

**APPLICATION** TIME FRAME

Annual permits required for spraying agricultural commodities. For other applications, a permit is required for each contract to apply pesticides. Permits

good for only one spray season. Application approval process takes

approximately 1 week.

Applicants must meet FAA and Vermont AOT requirements to operate aircraft.
