REGISTRATION OF ANIMAL SHELTERS AND FAIRS

SUMMARY DESCRIPTION OF PERMIT Any person who operates an animal shelter, fair, or auction, displaying animals for viewing and/or for sale, must register with the Department. The feeding, watering, housing, and general care of animals is subject to inspection to determine their health and humane care.

EXAMPLE OF REGULATED ACTIVITY

Humane Society Facilities; "Fairs".

CRITERIA FOR JURISDICTION

"Fairs" mean any public or privately operated facility where animals are confined for the purpose of display and/or sale or viewing. This includes USDA licensed exhibitors. "Animals" means any dog or cat, rabbit, rodent, non-human primate, bird or other warm-blooded vertebrate but shall not include horses, cattle, sheep, goats, swine, and domestic fowl.
