**SUMMARY  
DESCRIPTION  
OF PERMIT**

No person may transact the business of a livestock dealer, packer, or transporter unless the Commissioner has granted a license for that purpose. Livestock dealers and packers need to be bonded.

**EXAMPLE OF  
ACTIVITY**

Going from place to place buying or selling livestock, buying livestock for slaughter in the buyers packing plant, or transporting livestock for remuneration. Exception: regular operation of a farm or farm auction.

**CRITERIA FOR  
JURISDICTION**

"Livestock" means cattle, horses, sheep, swine, goats, camelids, fallow deer, red deer, reindeer, and American bison.
