RULES TO REGULATE THE USES OF BURR POND

TOWN OF SUDBURY

- Rule 1. No boat powered by motor shall be operated anywhere on Burr Pond in excess of 5 m.p.h. between the hours of 6:00 P.M. and 10:00 A.M. local time.
- Rule 2. Any power boat launched at the public Fish and Game access is to be utilized solely for the purpose of fishing on Burr Pond and shall be limited to a speed of 5 m.p.h. regardless of when or where operated on Burr Pond. A clearly visible and legible sign will be posted by the Agency of Environmental Conservation at the Fish and Game access area stating this rule and any other pertinent restrictions or regulations on the operation of such watercraft which apply.
- Rule 3. No houseboats or boats with living facilities are permitted on Burr Pond at any time.
- Rule 4. No person shall operate a motorboat in a manner which produces turbidity in violation of applicable Regulations Governing Water Classification and Control of Quality.
- Rule 5. These rules supplement and are not intended to modify other laws and regulations applicable to boating in Vermont.
- Rule 6. To the extent they have authority to do so, the selectmen of the Town of Sudbury may amplify or make ordinances to enforce these rules, in a manner consistent with them, as the public interest of all the citizens of the State warrants.
- Rule 7. The Vermont Water Resources Board retains continuing jurisdiction over the subject matter of these rules and may modify them, pursuant to statute, as it should determine the need to.
