RULES TO REGULATE THE USES OF VALLEY LAKE, TOWN OF WOODBURY

- Rule 1. No boat powered by motor shall be operated on Valley Lake in the Town of Woodbury at a speed in excess of 10 miles per hour when within 100 feet of the shoreline.
- Rule 2. No boat shall be operated on Valley Lake with a motor or engine whose rated capacity is in excess of 55 horse power.
- Rule 3. No houseboat or other boat with living facilities is permitted on Valley Lake.
- Rule 4. Waterskiing on Valley Lake shall be restricted to the hours from 10 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. No waterskiing is permitted within 100 feet of the shoreline.
- Rule 5. No motorboat shall be operated in a manner that produces turbidity of the waters of Valley Lake in violation of applicable Regulations Governing Water Classification and Control of Quality or that causes erosion of the shoreline or that results in damage to any existing fishery or to the aquatic environment.
- Rule 6. These rules supplement and are not intended to modify other applicable laws and regulations except as provided herein.
- Rule 7. To the extent they have authority to do so, the Selectmen of the Town of Woodbury may make ordinances to amplify or enforce these rules, in a manner consistent with them, as the public interest of all the citizens of the State may warrant.
- Rule 8. The Vermont Water Resources Board retains jurisdiction over the subject matter of these rules and may modify them in accordance with applicable statutes.
