RULES REGULATING THE USE OF EMERALD LAKE

- Rule 1. The operation of vessels powered by an internal combustion motor is prohibited.
- Rule 2. Vessels operated by agencies of the State of Vermont shall comply with Rule 1 at all times, except in cases where law enforcement, emergencies or performance of official duties requires otherwise.

NOTICE

In response to petition filed by the Department of Forests, Parks and Recreation, the Water Resources Board has decided to propose the following rules which would apply to Half Moon Pond (Town Hubbardton), Adams Reservoir (Town of Woodford), Lake Shaftsbury (Town of Shaftsbury), and Emerald Lake (Town of Dorset):

- Rule 1: The operation of vessels powered by an internal combustion motor is prohibited.
- Rule 2: Vessels operated by agencies of the State of Vermont shall comply with Rule 1 at all times, except in cases where law enforcement, emergencies or performance of official duties requires otherwise.

These rules are proposed under the authority of 10 V.S.A. §1424. The Water Resources Board will schedule a public hearing on these rules if requested to do so on or before July 7, 1986 by: 25 persons, a governmental subdivision or agency or an association having 25 or more members. The Water Resources Board will consider any written comments filed by July 14, 1986.
