I am writing regarding my opposition to the petition for closure of Danforth Cove. I have owned Camp # 107 for 42 years (1972). As a single woman with children the purchase of this camp was not only as a residence but as an investment in my future retirement. The closing of the cove for an undetermined length of time, without knowing the outcome, would create a great hardship putting in jeopardy everything that I have worked for all of these years. It is very unlikely anyone would want to purchase a camp on a lake that cannot be used! Therefore I would like you to seriously consider my opposition to the SLA petition for Danforth closure.

In prior years the lake level was lowered, perhaps this could be a solution allowing the mulfold to freeze or

allow for other treatments to be applied while exposed. I have enclosed a 1980 photo showing the lake water level lowered.
