PUBLIC NOTICE OF PETITION RECEIVED AND PUBLIC MEETING FOR WOLCOTT POND

July 11, 2013

The Watershed Management Division of the Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation (the Department) received a petition to amend the Vermont Use of Public Waters Rules to prohibit the use of vessels powered by internal combustion motors on Wolcott Pond. The petitioners are a citizen group called **Friends of Wolcott Pond**.

The petition was received on **February 22, 2013 and last revised on April 24, 2013**. The Department is currently considering this petition and seeking public comments.
