

## Wetland Permit Application Fees Starting July 1, 2015

Administrative fee: \$240

Wetland impact fee: \$0.75 per square foot (unchanged)

Wetland buffer impact fee: \$0.25 per square foot (unchanged)

Wetland impact fee for linear clearing: \$0.25 per square foot (unchanged)

Wetland “after-the-fact” impact fee: \$1.50 per square foot

Minimum Application Fee: \$50 (applied when impact fees total <\$50)  
(unchanged)

Cropland Conversion Flat Fee: \$200 (unchanged)

Application Revision Fee: \$100

→ Fee exemptions have been removed for municipalities and VTrans. All of the above fees are now applicable to all applicants.

Qualified “Linear clearing” is defined as: impact to Class I or II wetlands for utility line, pipeline and ski trail projects when the proposed impact is limited to clearing forested wetlands in a corridor and maintaining a cleared condition in that corridor for the project life.

“Cropland” is defined as: land that is used for the production of agricultural crops, including row crops, fibrous plants, pasture, fruit-bearing bushes, trees, or vines and the production of Christmas trees.

“after-the-fact” is when a permit is sought after the impact has taken place without a permit.
