

# Aquatic Nuisance Control General Permit

## Notice of Intent – Aquatic Nuisance Control Activity

Under Chapter 50 of Title 10, § 1455



<b>Application Number:</b> <i>For Lake &amp; Shoreland Permitting Use Only</i>
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Submission of this completed Notice of Intent (NOI) constitutes notice that the applicant identified in Section A intends to be authorized to conduct a nonchemical aquatic nuisance control activity in the waters identified in Section C that targets only aquatic plants using benthic barriers, diver assisted suction harvesting, or a combination of the two, under the [Aquatic Nuisance Control General Permit](#) (ANCGP). To be granted coverage, all information required on this form must be completed and the requisite fee must be submitted with the application (Section G). This authorization is subject to a minimum 14-day public comment period posted to the Environmental Notice Bulletin (<https://enb.vermont.gov>).




1. Scroll to the bottom of the page and click the  button.
