

Project Stages
















What is a Block Grant?



The Design/Implementation Block Grant Snapshot

- August 2019-December 2024
- Total funding: \$9,781,183
- Leverage to date: \$1,310,658
- Projects funded to date: 196





The Design/Implementation Block Grant Achievements

- Projects reported to date: 38 (~20%)
- Designs completed: 26
- Acres of floodplain restored: 11
- Linear feet of lakeshore restored: 670
- Acres of impervious surface treated: 40
- Estimated phosphorus reduced: 300 kg
