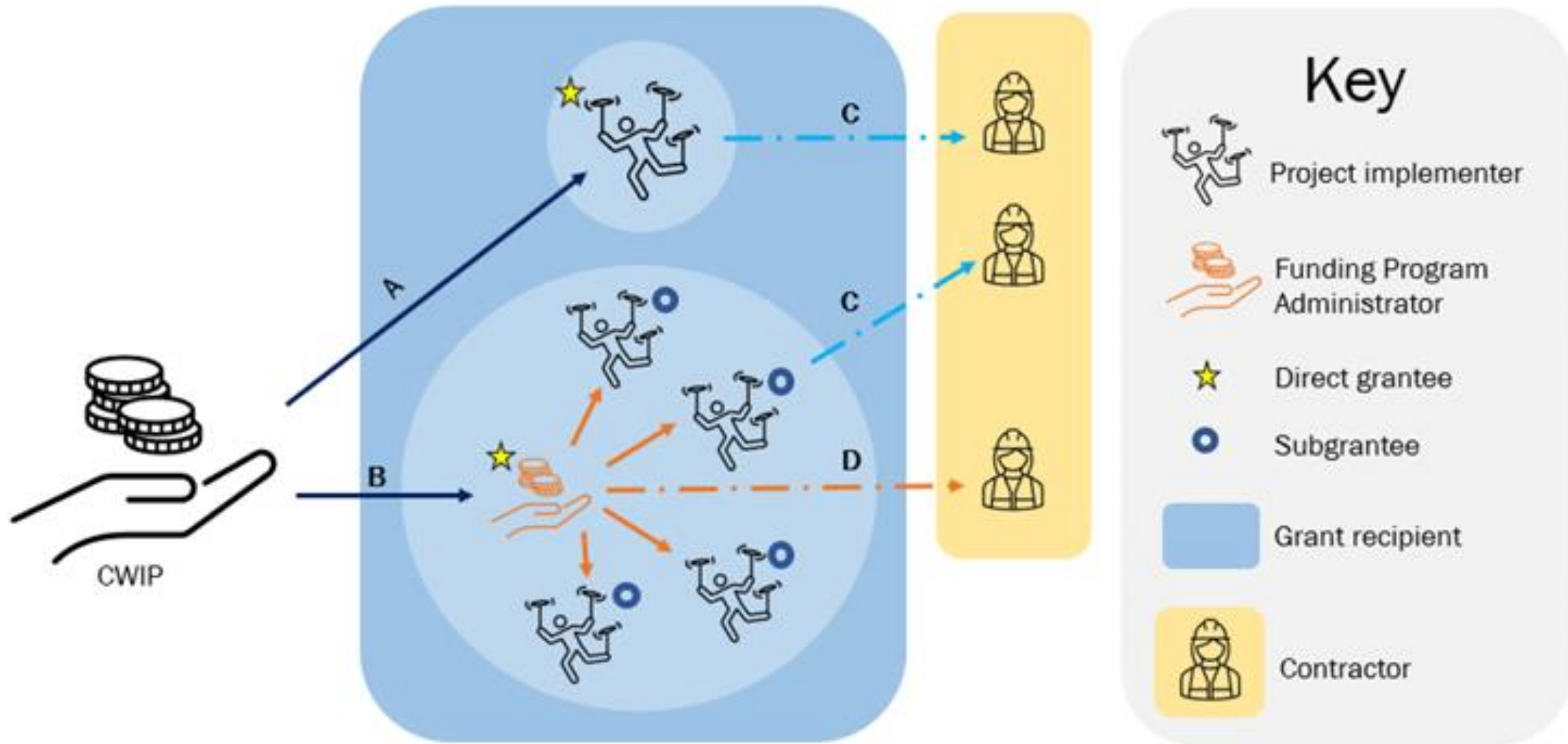

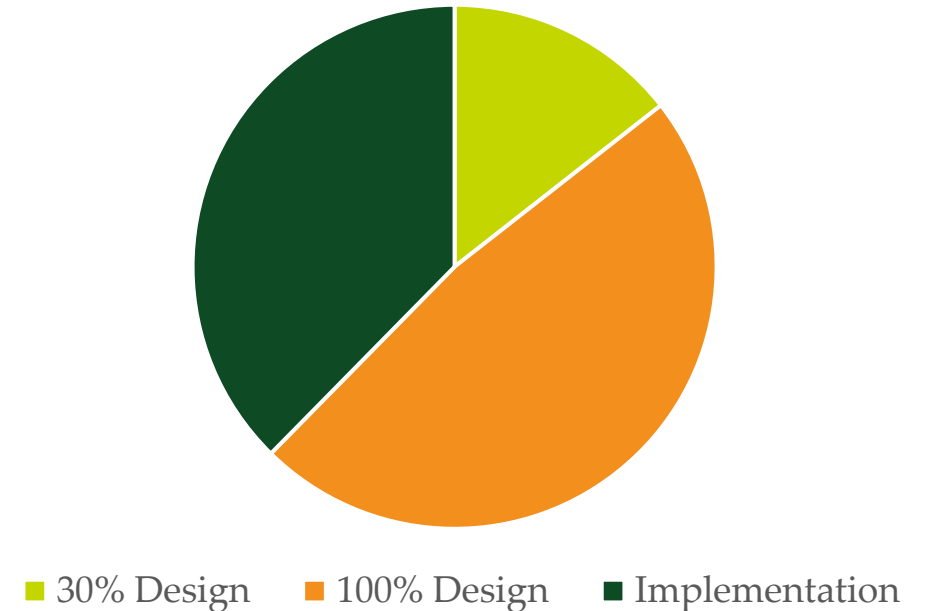
What is a Block Grant?



The Design/Implementation Block Grant Snapshot

- August 2019-December 2024
- Total funding: **\$9,781,183**
- Leverage to date: **\$1,310,658**
- Projects funded to date: **196**

Number of Projects Funded by Phase



The Design/Implementation Block Grant Achievements

- Projects reported to date: **38 (~20%)**
- Designs completed: **26**
- Acres of floodplain restored: **11**
- Linear feet of lakeshore restored: **670**
- Acres of impervious surface treated: **40**
- Estimated phosphorus reduced: **300 kg**
