Vermont – limited to Lake Champlain basin



Vermont SWAP – High Priority Species of Greatest Conservation Need










Goals:


Enhance the resiliency and long-term viability of the Lamoille River mudpuppy population by establishing a novel subpopulation upstream.

Increase our understanding of mudpuppy movement and migration for application in future conservation efforts.



























Approach for 2023
