

# NOTICE TO BUYER OF OUTDOOR HYDRONIC HEATER\*

This Notice is required by Section 5-204 of the Vermont Air Pollution Control Regulations. This Notice must be signed and dated by the buyer or lessee prior to the sale or lease of any outdoor hydronic heater to be installed in the State of Vermont.

**NOTICE** (please read the following information carefully):

These requirements apply to all certified outdoor hydronic heaters sold or leased for installation in Vermont.

1. It is illegal to burn: residential or commercial garbage; lawn clippings or yard waste; materials containing rubber, including tires; materials containing plastic; waste petroleum products, paints, paint thinners, or asphalt products; materials containing asbestos; construction or demolition debris; paper products, cardboard, plywood, or particleboard except that fire starters made from paper, cardboard, sawdust, wax or similar substances for the purpose of starting a fire are allowed; railroad ties, pressure treated wood or pallets; manure or animal remains; salt water driftwood or other previously salt water saturated materials; unseasoned wood; any materials not included in the warranty and owner's manual and any materials that were not included in the certification tests for the outdoor hydronic heater.
2. Certified outdoor hydronic heaters must be located more than 100 feet from any residence, school or health care facility not served by the boiler or owned by the buyer/lessee.
3. Use of a certified outdoor hydronic heater that meets the distance requirement is not appropriate in some areas due to terrain that could render the operation of an outdoor hydronic heater to be a nuisance or a public health hazard. Consider your neighbors when installing the outdoor hydronic heater.
4. The certified outdoor hydronic heater must be operated in conformance with the manufacturer's operating and maintenance instructions.
