

Notice to Buyer of Mid-Size Wood Fuel Burning Equipment

(Heat input of >350,000 to 3,000,000* BTUs per hour.)

This Notice is required by §5-205 of the Air Pollution Control Regulations. This Notice must be signed and dated by the buyer or lessee prior to the sale or lease of any mid-size wood fuel burning equipment to be installed in Vermont.
