Who is HPSA?

The Household Product Stewardship Alliance (HPSA) is a **501(c)(3) nonprofit organization** established to implement Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) laws for Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) materials.

HPSA aims to serve as the Stewardship Organization (SO) in Vermont.

Who is Leading HPSA?

HPSA is **temporarily** led by The Household & Commercial Products Association (HCPA).

HCPA is a 501(c)(6) trade association representing approximately 240 companies that manufacture, formulate, distribute, and sell products for household, institutional, commercial, and industrial use.

Why Temporarily?

The Stewardship Organization should be **producer-led** with the objective of providing a compliance pathway for producers with legal obligations under Vermont's law.



Why Should Producers Get Involved with HPSA?

Producers will be subject to a **sales ban** unless they are participating in a stewardship organization (such as HPSA) implementing an approved collection plan.

Only one stewardship organization is allowed in Vermont at the start of the program.



When Do Producers Need to Register with HPSA?

Producers must register with HPSA by **April 30, 2025**, to ensure ample time for HPSA to collect the information needed to set accurate fees and submit the required list of participating manufacturers and associated brands and products, as well as the five-year collection plan, to ANR by the July 1, 2025, deadline.
