- 2. A VOC was detected historically in the water system, but the compound has not been detected for three consecutive years of annual sampling; **OR**
- 3. The water system has received a reduction in VOCs sampling from annual to once every 3 years, *and* no VOCs were detected during the most recent sampling (within the last three years).

<u>Groundwater Systems:</u> The waiver period is **six years**. The water system is required to sample once during the waiver period. The waiver must be renewed after the first three years the waiver is in effect. Subsequently, the waiver must be renewed every six years.

<u>Surface Water Systems:</u> The waiver period is **three years**. The water system is required to sample once during the waiver period. The waiver must be renewed every three years.

A water system may be deemed eligible or ineligible for a waiver from SOCs sampling requirements based entirely on the vulnerability of the source water to contamination. *Systems utilizing Lake Champlain as a water source are ineligible for an SOCs waiver.*

- 1. The water system has completed at least one full round of SOCs sampling in the past three years, and no SOCs were detected; **OR**
- 2. An SOC was detected historically in the water system, but the compound has not been detected for three consecutive years of annual sampling.

An IOCs waiver is effective for up to **nine years** (one compliance cycle). If the Division grants the waiver request, the system will be required to take a minimum of one sample during the nine-year compliance cycle.

To be considered for an IOCs waiver, the water system must have submitted results for at least three compliance samples, including at least one taken after January 1, 1990.
