Instructions:

- 1. You must adhere to the Division's current Bulk Water Hauling Procedure.
- 2. Notify the Division of the need to haul water for an extended period at 802-828-1535.
- 3. Complete all sections of this form after each load is hauled. Email completed form to **David.Love@vermont.gov.**
- 4. If a Boil Water notice is required (see current <u>Boil Water Procedure</u>), complete the Boil Water Notice template and submit a copy to the Division.
