If the Owner is an association or corporation, it must be a valid legal entity in active standing with the Vermont Secretary of State's Corporations Division. Authorized individuals include a principal/member of the owning

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entity registered with the Vermont Secretary of State Corporations Division, a board president, committee chair, or other legally authorized individual.
