PUBLIC NOTICE**

On January 15, 2016, **The City of Burlington, Burlington International Airport**, filed application **#2CD-WHRH-NQ1N, version 2**, for a Project generally described as:

The **Air Carrier Apron** (also referred to as the "Main Apron") is an existing paved area at the **City of Burlington's Burlington International Airport ("BTV")** used primarily for loading and unloading of commercial passenger aircraft. Historically, Aircraft Deicing Fluid ("ADF") has been applied to aircraft at the Air Carrier Apron, as a necessary safety practice for cold-weather flights. Runoff from the Air Carrier Apron is diverted to an existing infiltration system in accordance with Underground Injection Control ("UIC") permit #6-0075. BTV is requesting a major amendment to the current UIC permit to perform upgrades to the effluent storage and pumping components and to reconstruct the subsurface infiltration field, to improve the reliability of the system that manages ADF-containing runoff from the Air Carrier Apron. Original renewal application materials were received on July 13, 2011. BTV maintains its' permit status in accordance with Title 3 Section 814, until a determination is made on the pending application.
