NOTICE OF INFORMAL PUBLIC HEARING

PURPOSE: Informal Public Hearing regarding the proposed Indirect Discharge

Permit ID-9-0331 for Hog Island Wholesale Bait & Tackle

LOCATION: Swanton Town Office Building, 1 Academy Street, Swanton, Vermont

DATE/TIME: May 22, 2018 6:30 pm - 8:30 pm.

PROCESS: Vermont Indirect Discharge Rules, Section14-504(d)

Hearings held pursuant to this section will be conducted by a duly authorized representative of the Secretary. Any person may submit oral or written statements and data at the hearing concerning the draft permit. The Secretary shall have discretion to limit the time allowed for oral statements and may require the submission of statements in writing. All statements, comments and data presented at the hearing shall be retained and considered in the formulation of the final determination on the draft permit. The submission of written testimony at the hearing is encouraged.

The public hearing shall be informal and not subject to the contested case provisions of 10 V.S.A. Chapter 25.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD:

The public comment period for the proposed indirect discharge permit ID-9-0331 will extend 10 days from the date of the public hearing to June 1, 2018. Comments must be submitted in writing prior to 4:30 p.m. June 1, 2018 to the Agency of Natural Resources, Department of Environmental Conservation, 1 National Life Drive - Main 2, Montpelier, VT 05620-3521.
