Composting and Incinerating Toilets Guidance Document February 24, 2020

The use of composting toilets and incinerating toilets require a permit by the Agency of Natural Resources (Agency) under the Wastewater System and Potable Water Supply Rules (Rules). The contents removed from a composting toilet or incinerator toilet are considered to contain pathogens and disposal of the contents must comply with § 1-929 of the Rules. The following outlines the requirements of for disposal of the contents of composting toilet or incinerating toilet.

- <u>Burial</u> the contents can be buried on the same lot which the toilet is located in a location permitted by the Agency that complies with § 1-929(c)(1) of the Rules. For more information, go to <u>https://dec.vermont.gov/water/ww-systems</u>.
- 2. <u>Landfill</u> the contents can be disposed at a landfill or transfer station (destined for a landfill) without the need for a Solid Waste certification.
- 3. <u>Wastewater Treatment Facility</u> the contents can be and disposed of at a wastewater treatment facility, provided the facility accepts the compost, without the need for a Solid Waste certification.
