## REQUIREMENTS OF ACT 21 (S.49) FOR PUBLIC WATER SYSTEMS

- 1. Interim standard of 20 ppt (20 nanograms per liter, or ng/l). Testing of all communities and NTNCs by December 1, 2019.
- 2. If 20 ng/l exceeded during interim monitoring, system must remedy (e.g. new source(s) or treatment) and must issue a Do Not Drink public notice until resolved.
- 3. ANR must establish an MCL in the Water Supply Rule by February 1, 2020.
- 4. Adjustments to 20 ng/l interim standard can be made for the MCL (EPA develops MCLs that consider cost and technical feasibility criteria, and Act 21 allows those considerations.)
- 5. ANR is required to publish an Advance Notice of Proposed Rulemaking for PFAS as a class by 8/1/2020.
- 6. ANR is required to file a proposed rule to regulate or not regulate PFAS as a class by March 1, 2021, with consideration of the legal, technical, and other impediments.
- 7. ANR must perform a pilot study at a public water system using TOP assay or other method to identify total PFAS, by July 1, 2019.
- 8. ANR is required to publish a plan for public comment to collect data for contaminants in drinking water from community and NTNCs, for which a health advisory has been established, where no MCL has been adopted.
