## **Pollution Abatement Facility Operator Licensing**

SUMMARY DESCRIPTION OFLICENSE Pursuant to 2016, No. 156, §§ 13-14, pollution abatement facility operators are licensed by the Secretary of State's Office of Professional Regulation (OPR), effective January 1, 2017. Although the agency providing licenses has changed, the qualifications required to obtain and maintain a license of a particular class and grade remain the same. All DEC-certified system operators should have applied for and received an OPR license in late 2016.

EXAMPLE OF REGULATED ACTIVITY

"Practice of pollution abatement facility operation" means the operation and maintenance of a facility regulated under 10 V.S.A. § 1263 by a person required by the terms of a permit to hold particular credentials, including those of an "operator," "assistant chief operator," or "chief operator." 26 V.S.A. §5102(4)

CRITERIA FOR JURISDICTION

Licensing requirements can be found within the statutes and administrative rules.
