PUBLIC DRINKING WATER SYSTEM — OPERATOR CERTIFICATION

SUMMARY DESCRIPTION OF PERMIT	A certification issued by the Secretary pursuant to Chapter 21, Water Supply Rule. Owners of Public Drinking Water Systems are required to contract with a certified operator for system operation.
REGULATED ACTIVITY	Individuals who operate Public Drinking Water Systems
CRITERIA FOR JURISDICTION	Certified Operators are required for all Public Drinking Water Systems, as defined in Chapter 21, Water Supply Rule.
INFORMATION REQUIRED	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Submit application 2. Meet educational and experience requirement 3. Successfully complete written examination, except for Class 1 Certification 4. Pay required fee 5. Satisfy all state mandated requirements for professional licensing and certification.

FEES	All Class 1A and 1B - \$45.00 per initial certificate or renewal. All Other Classes - \$80.00 per initial certificate or renewal.
APPLICATION TIME FRAME	The performance standard for processing a complete application is 30 days for original certifications and renewals. Please apply at least 30 days before expiration date.
