PERMIT AND LICENSE INFORMATION

HAZARDOUS WASTE HANDLER SITE ID FORM

**SUMMARY
DESCRIPTION
OF PERMIT**

Under the Vermont Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (VHWMR), any person who generates or transports hazardous waste, or who owns or operates a facility that treats, stores, disposes, or recycles hazardous waste, must “notify” the Waste Management & Prevention Division (WMPD) of such activity.

Notification is accomplished by submitting a site-specific **Hazardous Waste Handler Site ID Form** to the WMPD. While this form does not need to be re-submitted on a regular basis, it must be revised/resubmitted whenever the information required by the form changes.

Also, if a business handles hazardous waste at multiple properties located in Vermont, each “site” is considered a separate “handler” and is subject to the notification requirement.

**INFORMATION
REQUIRED**

In general, the **Hazardous Waste Handler Site ID Form** requires: general facility information; information about the site location and activities conducted at the site; the site mailing address; site contact information; identification of the site owner and operator; a description of hazardous waste, universal waste and used oil activities conducted at the site; and specific information about the types and quantities of hazardous waste and universal waste generated and/or handled.

In addition to keeping the information required by the **Hazardous Waste Handler Site ID Form** up-to-date, a revised **Hazardous Waste Handler Site ID Form** must be submitted to the WMPD upon transfer of ownership of any site/facility that is subject to the notification requirement.

FEES

While no fee is assessed for notification, annual generator fees are assessed based on the waste generation information provided on the Hazardous Waste Handler Site ID form as follows:

Conditionally exempt generators: \$ 75 per year
Small quantity generators: \$125 per year
Large quantity generators: \$600 per year
