| SUMMARY<br>DESCRIPTION OF<br>PERMIT  | Allows for the certification of redemption centers and approves all beverage container labels that are required to carry the "VT 5¢" message.  |

| EXAMPLES OF<br>REGULATED<br>ACTIVITY | Certifies redemption centers. Registers beverage manufacturers prior to the sale of malt beverages, mineral waters, mixed wine drinks, soda water, carbonated soft drinks, liquor and spirits in Vermont.  |
| INFORMATION<br>REQUIRED              | Submittal of redemption center certification applications indicating the location<br>of the redemption center and the estimated number of containers handled per<br>year. Submittal of beverage manufacturer registrations prior to product being<br>sold or distributed in Vermont.   |
