**PERMIT AND LICENSE INFORMATION**

**ENERGIZING PERMIT - ELECTRICAL**

**SUMMARY DESCRIPTION OF PERMIT** An energizing permit is required before the electrical utility company energizes any new electrical service in a public building.

**CRITERIA FOR JURISDICTION** The state or municipal electrical inspector will issue the energizing permit when the new installation is in substantial compliance with the requirements.

**FEES** No separate fee; covered through the electrical permit for installation.

**APPLICATION TIME FRAME** Within 5 days of the request for an inspection, an inspection will be conducted, scheduled, or waived.
