## **PLUMBING PERMIT - INSTALLATION**

SUMMARY DESCRIPTION OF PERMIT

A plumbing permit is required for all plumbing installations in public buildings and any private residence that is connected to a public water and/or public sewer system to insure that qualified persons properly install the plumbing work.

INFORMATION REQUIRED

The master plumber or specialist plumber submits a work notice to the regional office indicating the scope of the plumbing work to be done. Inspections may be scheduled to review the work, and other Division inspectors may check to see that properly licensed persons are doing the work.

**FEES** 

The schedule of fees is contained in the Vermont Plumbing Rules and is based on the size and number of plumbing components covered by the permit and whether the work is classified as priority or non-priority work.

APPLICATION TIME FRAME
