AIRPORTS

SUMMARY DESCRIPTION OF PERMIT Establishment and operation of any aircraft landing area requires Agency approval. AOT Certificate of Approval indicates compliance with all statutory requirements and minimum safety standards. The establishment and/or operation of an aircraft landing area.

REGULATED ACTIVITY EXAMPLE

Any permanent facilities, publicly or privately owned, for use by any type aircraft (airplanes, seaplanes, ultra-lights, balloons, and/or helicopters).

CRITERIA FOR JURISDICTION

Requires safety inspection by Agency Aeronautics Specialist, written municipal approval, and notification to FAA.

INFORMATION REQUIRED

Completed application form with sketch indicating location, runway orientation and dimensions, adjoining property owners, landing surface material, and relevant terrain features. Correspondence from Select Board Chair indicating municipal approval. Completed copy of FAA Form 7480-1 as filed with the FAA.

Two months.
