Allows use of pesticides on a golf course.

EXAMPLE OF REGULATED ACTIVITY

All golf courses, whether existing or proposed must obtain a permit to apply pesticides prior to the use of pesticides. Proposed golf courses are reviewed

prior to or coincidentally with Act 250 review.

INFORMATION REQUIRED

Pesticide management plan, maps, site description and information on pesticides proposed for use; information identifying surface water, private

water sources of abutting landowners, public water services.
