PESTICIDES: GOLF COURSE PERMITS

SUMMARY DESCRIPTION OF PERMIT

Allows use of pesticides on a golf course.

EXAMPLE OF REGULATED ACTIVITY

All golf courses, whether existing or proposed must obtain a permit to apply pesticides prior to the use of pesticides. Proposed golf courses are reviewed prior to or coincidentally with [Act 250](#) review.

INFORMATION REQUIRED

Pesticide management plan, maps, site description and information on pesticides proposed for use; information identifying surface water, private water sources of abutting landowners, public water services.
