**NURSERY DEALERS LICENSE AND NURSERY INSPECTION CERTIFICATE**

<b>SUMMARY DESCRIPTION OF PERMIT</b>	The Secretary may inspect and certify nursery stock in the possession of a licensed nursery grower or nursery dealer.
<b>EXAMPLE OF REGULATED ACTIVITY</b>	Greenhouses, nurseries, garden centers growing, purchasing, selling or installing live plants.
<b>INFORMATION REQUIRED</b>	Name and address; maintain plant purchase, sale and distribution records for one year, to be made available to Secretary for inspection upon request.
