## UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY

In accordance with Title 40 of the United States Code of Federal Regulations, Section 271.21(b)(4), the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is hereby giving notice of its proposal to approve the State of Vermont's revised hazardous waste management program.

Vermont has applied for final authorization for revisions to its hazardous waste program under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA). EPA reviewed Vermont's application and has made a determination, subject to public review and comment, that Vermont's hazardous waste program revisions satisfy all of the requirements necessary to qualify for Final Authorization. Vermont's program revision authorization application will be available for public review at <u>www.regulations.gov</u> under Docket ID No. EPA-R01-RCRA-2022-0864.

DATES: Comments on Vermont's program revision authorization application must be received by the close of business thirty (30) days after publication in the **Federal Register**. The proposed **Federal Register** notice should be published in late February 2023.

SUMMARY: The State of Vermont is seeking authorization for revisions to its hazardous waste management regulations and program. Vermont initially received Final authorization to operate its Hazardous Waste Management Program on January 21, 1985, with subsequent authorized revisions. Vermont submitted its application on November 29, 2022, for this latest update, and upon review EPA has determined that the State's hazardous waste program revisions satisfy all of the requirements necessary to qualify for Final authorization. Vermont is seeking authorization of state regulations for generators, e-manifest, pharmaceuticals, recalled airbags, aerosol cans, and import and export requirements. A complete listing of the revisions can be found in the Federal Register.
