## Interim Petroleum Cleanup Fund Maximum Reimbursement Rates May 2020

A list of maximum reimbursement rates relating to site investigation and monitoring tasks is included in the *Procedures for Reimbursement from The Petroleum Cleanup Fund,* effective September 2014. Recent issues pertaining to the reimbursement of select spill response related items has prompted the Vermont Agency of Natural Resources, Department of Environmental Conservation, Waste Management and Prevention Division to develop reimbursement rates for select expendable items. A complete revision of the maximum Petroleum Cleanup Fund (PCF) reimbursement rates will be undertaken in 2020. In the interim, the maximum PCF reimbursement rates provided in the PCF reimbursement guidance and in the list below are effective. The rates provided below are subject to change.

Expendables	
Item	Maximum Rate/Unit
Drum, 55-gallon, open top, steel	\$50/each
Polyethylene roll, 100'x20', 6-mil	\$150/each
Polyethylene roll, 100'x20', 4-mil	\$100/each
Oil-absorbent boom, 10'x5", (4) per bale	\$140/bale
Oil-absorbent boom, 10'x8", (4) per bale	\$200/bale
Oil-absorbent sock, 3" x 48", (30) per bale	\$87.50/bale
Oil-absorbent pads, 15"x19", (100) per bale	\$65/bale
Gloves, nitrile, disposable (100) per box	\$15.50/box
BioSolve, 1-gallon container	\$65/gallon

In order to receive reimbursement for any item(s) on the list above, a PCF reimbursement claim must be provided to the WMPD in accordance with Chapter 9 of the PCF reimbursement guidance. Reimbursement approval is subject to fund availability and WMPD review of the claim and any associated, required deliverable.
