	B. A Post-Closure Plan: The plan should include provisions for each of the following (as applicable to the landfill infrastructure):
	Groundwater Monitoring
	Surface Water Monitoring
	Air Monitoring
	Leachate Monitoring
	Erosion and Drainage Control
	Inspections and Reporting
	Maintenance of leachate and gas systems
	Description of any potential planned uses of the property
	Plans should detail the specific activities and analysis that will occur each year and a schedule for implementation. Consideration should be given to the performance objectives of the post-closure activities and demonstration of conformance with the <i>Procedure Addressing</i>
	Groundwater Quality Monitoring and Responses When a Groundwater Standard is Reached or
	Exceeded at Municipal Solid Waste Landfills. Requests for reductions in monitoring should be
	justified by an analysis of existing data. As appropriate, a site plan(s), including applicable monitoring locations, should be included.
	C. Evidence that the facility is included in an adopted solid waste implementation plan: a letter from the planning entity or a copy of the appropriate documentation within the approved plan is sufficient.
	D. A cost estimate for the remaining period of post-closure care or the upcoming certification period: This cost estimate must be based on the current status and post-closure activities occurring at the facility and should be updated as modifications to monitoring, inspection and reporting procedures are made over the life-time of the facility.
	E. Evidence of sufficient financial responsibility or capability for post-closure care. For municipal applicants, evidence of annual appropriation of funds is acceptable (e.g. a letter from the treasurer). For private entities, financial assurance shall be established as provided within the Solid Waste Management Rules.
	F. Notice of Application: The applicant shall provide notice to adjoining property owners using the Department of Environmental Conservation <u>template letter</u> (2-pages) at the point of application. Included within this application, the applicant should provide a signed certification stating that all adjoining property owners, with names and addresses included, were notified by the appropriate template.
	G. Background Disclosure Statements: All nonmunicipal applicants are required to complete a <u>Personal History</u> Disclosure and <u>Business Disclosure</u> statement in addition to the application (§10 V.S.A. 6605(h))

5. Required Supporting Documents: The following documents and information <u>must</u> be submitted with this form for the application to be complete. Most of these documents require at least minimal revision from one certification period to the next; however, even if no changes are made, please
