State law (10 V.S.A. § 1523) requires retailers of beverages covered in Vermont's beverage container redemption law (a.k.a. "Bottle Bill") to accept for redemption any containers of a kind, size, and brand sold by that retailer, unless they have prior approval from the Secretary of the Agency of Natural Resources exempting them from this requirement "if a redemption center or centers are established that serve a public need" under 10 V.S.A. §1523(b).
