The Agency has reviewed the amended paint stewardship plan that was submitted by PaintCare originally on March 30, 2017 and then revised and resubmitted on August 18, 2017. The paint stewardship plan dated August 18<sup>th</sup> is hereby approved. The stewardship plan included a revision related to the requirement that PaintCare must allow interested paint retailers the opportunity to participate as a collection site, provide the retailer complies with applicable laws and regulations. Per electronic mail on August 18, 2017, PaintCare stated that they are committed to this requirement and do not intend to debate this requirement at a later date. The draft stewardship plan was posted for public comment through September 25<sup>th</sup>. No comments were received.

The paint stewardship plan is approved for a five-year period to expire on June 30, 2022.
