### APPROVED COMPOST OPERATOR TRAINING PROGRAMS

All operators of composting facilities regulated by the Solid Waste Management Program are required to complete an approved training course. See <u>Solid Waste Management Rules</u> §6- 1105(d)(5) and §6-1108(a)(10).

### **Vermont Compost Operator Training Course**

The 2021 Vermont Compost Operator Training will be held in the fall and will likely be held remotely via webinar sessions and a few pre-recorded units. Exact date to be determined.
