### RULES TO REGULATE THE USES OF LITTLE HOSMER POND, TOWN OF CRAFTSBURY

- Rule 1. Waterskiing is prohibited on Little Hosmer Pond in the Town of Craftsbury.
- Rule 2. Boats powered by motors of more than 10 horsepower are prohibited on Little Hosmer Pond.
- Rule 3. No person shall operate a boat powered by motor at any time at a speed in excess of 5 miles per hour on Little Hosmer Pond.
- Rule 4. No motorboat shall be operated in a manner that produces turbidity of the waters on Little Hosmer Pond in violation of applicable Regulations Governing Water Classification and Control of Quality or that causes erosion of the shoreline or that results in damage to any existing fishery or to the aquatic environment.
- Rule 5. No houseboats or boats with living facilities are permitted on Little Hosmer Pond at any time.
- Rule 6. These rules supplement and are not intended to modify other applicable laws and regulations except as provided herein.
- Rule 7. To the extent they have authority to do so, the selectmen of the Town of Craftsbury may make ordinances to amplify or enforce these rules, in a manner consistent with them, as the public interest of all the citizens of the State warrants.
- Rule 8. The Vermont Water Resources Board retains jurisdiction over the subject matter of these rules and may modify them in accordance with applicable statutes.
